

# Stock Confirmed Page — Quick Guide

## What This Page Is

This admin screen lists model codes that are already matched to WooCommerce products and treated as **confirmed for stock**. Use it to export, review, or undo confirmations; move items back to manual review; and blacklist model–product pairs you never want auto■matched again.

## What Shows Here

- Explicitly flagged stock confirmations: `bsv_confirmed_sources[code]['stock'] = true`.
- Rows with `source == 'stock'`.
- Legacy auto matches where there is *no price flag* present (treated as stock/legacy).

## Badges & Labels

- **Stock** — explicitly stock■confirmed or inferred as stock.
- **Stock/Legacy** — legacy entries with no explicit price flag.

## Columns Explained

- 1 **Model Code** – your sheet code key; manual/auto indicator is shown in grey.
- 2 **Product ID** – WooCommerce product ID.
- 3 **Product Name** – resolved from `wc_get_product()`.
- 4 **Stock** – current WooCommerce stock qty.
- 5 **Source** – Stock or Stock/Legacy.
- 6 **Actions** – Blacklist pair and Send to Manual Review.

## Actions You Can Take

- 1 **Export Confirmed Matches to CSV** — downloads `confirmed_matches_stock.csv` of what you see here.
- 2 **Search** — type in the filter box to narrow rows instantly.
- 3 **Remove Selected / Remove All** — delete confirmations (be careful).
- 4 **Clear All** — unticks checkboxes only.
- 5 **Send to Manual Review** — moves the row to the manual queue and records a label & suggestions. This is how you undo a confirmation without deleting history.
- 6 **Don't auto■match (Blacklist)** — stores a *pair* of (model code + product ID). Future syncs will not auto■confirm that exact pair. Also writes a *Last Match* entry so you can see it on the Stock Blacklist page immediately.

## How “Send to Manual Review” Works

- Removes the item from confirmed lists (`bsv_confirmed_matches`, `bsv_confirmed_meta`).
- Adds a pending entry under `bsv_pending_manual_matches[code]` with `status='rejected'`.

- Captures a human-readable *label* (e.g., “Product Name (SKU)”).
- Optionally populates *manual\_review* suggestions via your fuzzy matcher.

## Blacklist Details (Stock)

- When you tick *Don't auto-match* and submit, the exact (code, product) pair is written via `bsv_blacklist_pair(code, product_id, 'stock')`.
- A record is also saved in `bsv_blacklist_last_stock` so the Stock Blacklist page shows a *Last Match* value immediately.

## Troubleshooting

- Empty table? Confirm the `bsv_confirmed_matches` option actually has entries; verify your sync ran and saved confirmations.
- PDF doesn't open? Ensure the file exists at `admin/images/stock-confirmed-guide.pdf` and ThickBox is loaded (WordPress loads it when `add_thickbox()` is called).
- Mismatch between sites? Verify options/migration across environments and that capabilities allow the page to load.
- If a product name shows as “Not Found”, the product ID no longer resolves in WooCommerce.

## Where to Put This File

Upload this PDF to your plugin at **`admin/images/stock-confirmed-guide.pdf`**. On the page, click “**Open Confirmed Matches Guide**” — it opens in a ThickBox modal. A secondary button opens the same PDF in a new browser tab.
